Berit Lindfeldt is a Swedish artist who works in materials such as steel, bronze, concrete and rubber.

Deform's first project with Berit Lindfeldt was in 2003. Decorating the plant science institute in Alnarp, the result was "Sun colander". We have now also made: "Ball" (in Majorna, Gothenburg); a stainless steel jug for Volvo's head office in Lundby; and, "Spring ball", which can be seen in Årsta.

We look forward to this collaboration continuing with similarly exciting works of art!

The Lundby jug is around 1,600 mm high and, supplied via a pipe in a closed system, has water flowing from its spout.
